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Showers and TS will fire again late this afternoon, and each afternoon thru at least Sunday, with 30-35KT winds possible each day. IFR ceilings will set up between midnight and 01L and linger until 08/09L tomorrow morning. Showers and TS activity will develop during the afternoon tomorrow and could linger into the first half of the N1. Anticipate TEMPO IFR w/ TS during the N1 tomorrow. Friday will be more of the same, transitioning to predominant IFR near midnight. That trend will continue thru the weekend. Monday and Tuesday will be predominant VFR all periods with isolated afternoon showers and thunderstorms.
